We examined your photographs. In our professional opinion, the coin pictured is:

#1. An authentic 1859-C Liberty Head Half Eagle.

#2. Your photographs (rated 7 / 10) are okay for determining grade and authenticity. This coin may be a counterfeit, but if it is, it is very good. Some images make the coin appear to have grainy surfaces, as a cast counterfeit. Other photographs do not. Regardless, this is a coin we always recommend purchasing or selling certified.

#3. Current Market Value (10/03/2018)

This coin, once certified authentic, has a value of between \$1,200 and \$1,500 to a private party buyer. An honest dealer will likely offer you between 50% and 70% of that value.
